- 1. At the Tesla Stations what are the numbers on the mail boxes?
  - 105 and 125
- 2. Where is Doc Holliday buried exactly in the cemetery?
  - Due to missing records nobody knows exactly
- 3. What were Doc Holliday's last words?
  - "This is funny"
- 4. When was Doc Holliday born, and when did he die? (2 Points)
  - Born 8/14/1851 died 11/8/1887
- 5. Instead of mile markers on 4 Mile Rd, they used letters. How many letters were used and which ones?
  - 5, ABCDE
- 6. 63 years ago was 1952...What was the number one song for the year? And who was it by? (2 points)
  - Cry by Johnny Ray
- 7. Sticking to the number 63...In 1963, what was the number one Beatles song of the year?
  - She Loves You
- 8. Besides Abington, England, name the other city and country where the MGA was produced.
  - Enfield, New South Wales, Australia
- 9. What 2 main features distinguished the MGA 1600 MkII De Luxe from the MGA 1600 MkII?
  - four-wheel disc brakes and centre-lock steel disc wheels
- 10. What 3 engine sizes in cc's were used in the MGA? (3 points)
  - 1489cc, 1588cc (MGA 1600 and MGA Twin-Cam) and 1622cc.
    - \*Originally the Twin-Cam engine was intended to be a 1489cc unit but was changed just before production to the 1588cc unit to take advantage of the new 1600cc competition engine class. The twin cam engine used a normal 1489cc cylinder block with the 88.9mm stroke but with a bore of 75.414mm gave the motor 1588cc capacity.
